On April 10, 2020, Seneca Healthcare District (SHD) identified our first positive COVID-19 case in our area. All information regarding the case is managed by Plumas County Public Health Agency (PCPHA). SHD is conducting an investigation along with PCPHA into any possible exposure to SHD and our community. If exposure is identified, those persons will be contacted by a member of the Public Health COVID-19 Response Team for further screening.

We are taking every precaution to ensure ongoing safety of our patients, residents, staff and community during this ever-changing event.

At this time the most important thing you can do is continue to practice social distancing and stay home, only making essential outings for groceries or medical care. Staying safe and healthy is what will help our community most in the long run. If you do have to venture out for essentials, please wear a mask.

If you or a loved one is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 we ask that you call your primary care provider so that initial screening can be done. Calling first is so important and allows us to take the necessary precautions to prepare for your visit.
