COVID-19 EXPOSURE MASS TESTING CLINIC

If you or anyone in your household has been exposed to a recent positive case within the last 7-14 days and need to be tested for COVID-19 please join us November 3.

STEP 1

- On the day of testing, arrive to the front hospital parking lot and follow directions and signage (Take Riverwood Dr. off Hwy 36 and turn right on Brentwood Dr.)
- Have a form of photo ID ready and your insurance card
- Paperwork will be completed during this step
- Please do not get out of your car

STEP 2

- Specimen collection (via nasal swab) will take place at the second stop following registration
- Notification of results - if your test is positive you will be notified by phone call from Plumas County Public Health. If your result is negative there will be no phone call. You can access your results in your Patient Portal or by calling Medical Records at 530-258-1902

If you would like to be tested and it is not related to the recent positive COVID-19 cases in the area, Plumas District Hospital in Quincy is offering weekly testing or you can call your primary care provider.
