Final payment shall be determined by the District from measured quantities of work performed based upon the Unit Price.

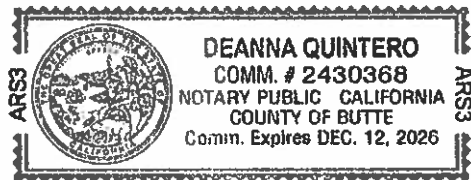
